State Versus Rampal

Present: Shri Gajender Mor, Public Prosecutor for the State  
All the accused on bail except Rampal with counsel

Shri R.S. Hooda, counsel for the Rampal-accused.

An application has been filed by the learned counsel representing Rampal-accused for exemption from his personal appearance submitting that Rampal accused is heading a religious trust and there is a dispute between his disciples and Arya Samajis which caused lot of law and order problem. Learned counsel submitted that accused Rampal has no objection if the evidence is recorded in his absence and he would not raise any dispute regarding his identification.

It is submitted by learned Public Prosecutor that the prosecution has no objection if the presence of the accused Rampal is exempted keeping in view the law and order situation which arises if the Rampal appears in the Court on account of conflict between his disciples and Arya Samajis. In view of that, the personal appearance of Rampal accused is exempted till further orders.

Now, for evidence of the prosecution, the case is adjourned to 10.3.2014. On the request of the learned Public Prosecutor, only, PWs namely Jaipal, Bijender, Randhir, Dharampal, Ram Rattan, Kapil and Mahender be summoned for the adjourned date.
